## Literacy Tip:

## Phonological and Phonemic Awareness

Before a child can read, he or she needs a solid foundation of phonological and phonemic awareness: the ability to hear and manipulate different sounds in words. Can your child:

- -Count the words on a page?
- -Separate and count the syllables in words?
- -Put sounds together to make a word? If you say /f/ and /ish/, can he or she put them together to make fish?
- -Identify the first sound in a word? If you say cat, can they isolate /c/?
- -Identify the last sound in a word? If you say dog, can they isolate /g/?
